Programming

Some programs have multiple sessions. Each session is independent of the last and you must register and pay for each session. Payments must be received before your registration is considered complete.

Prices, dates, times, locations, and class limits are subject to change. Although we do our best to avoid changes, some may occur due to unavoidable circumstances.

Registrations are accepted online, over the phone, and in person at our Parks & Recreation Administrative Office in Koontz Park, located at 2391 Harts Lane, Lafayette Hill.

We highly recommend that you sign up early, as some programs do fill quickly.

Age Requirements

Age qualification is determined by the age of the participant as of the first day of the program or class. Participants who have not yet completed a full year of kindergarten will be required to have a parent/guardian attend the program or class. In some cases, proof of kindergarten completion may be required.

Medical Information

Medial information is required for all program participants, and all information will be kept confidential. This includes, but is not limited to, allergies, learning disabilities, and other professional diagnoses. Please communicate any changes in medical information to us to help us make your experience safe and fun.

Inclement Weather

Cancellations and location changes are communicated in a number of ways. Please reference the Parks & Recreation Facebook Page, website, or RainedOut text messaging service for notices.

To subscribe to RainedOut text or e-mail notifications, please use the keyword provided for each specific program or class.

Cancellation & Refund Policy

Whitemarsh Township reserves the right to cancel any programs. In the event a program is cancelled, a full refund will be issued. If you wish to cancel a registration for any reason, a minimum of two weeks from the start date of the program or class is required to receive a full refund. Refunds are not issued after the program or class start date. There is a \$5.00 processing fee on all refunds.


