Programming

Some programs have multiple sessions. Each session is independent of the last and you must register and pay for each session. Payments must be received before your registration is considered complete.

Prices, dates, times, locations, and class limits are subject to change. Although we do our best to avoid changes, some may occur due to unavoidable circumstances.

Registrations are accepted online, over the phone, and in person at our Parks & Recreation Administrative Office in Koontz Park, located at 2391 Harts Lane, Lafayette Hill.

We highly recommend that you sign up early, as some programs do fill quickly.

Age Requirements

Age qualification is determined by the age of the participant as of the first day of the program or class. Participants who have not yet completed a full year of kindergarten will be required to have a parent/guardian attend the program or class. In some cases, proof of kindergarten completion may be required.

Medical Information

Medical information is required for all program participants, and all information will be kept confidential. This includes, but is not limited to, allergies, learning disabilities, and other professional diagnoses. Please communicate any changes in medical information to us to help us make your experience safe and fun.

Inclement Weather

Cancellations and location changes are communicated in a number of ways. Please reference the Parks & Recreation Facebook Page, website, or RainedOut text messaging service for notices.

RainedOut Messaging Service

Each program has a designated "keyword". Text the program's "keyword" to "84483" to subscribe to the text notifications. Notifications will only be sent out in case of emergencies, cancellations, or other necessary situations. You can unsubscribe from the notifications at anytime. You will need to re-subscribe to the service for each program session.

Cancellation & Refund Policy

Whitemarsh Township reserves the right to cancel any programs. In the event a program is cancelled, a full refund will be issued. If you wish to cancel a registration for any reason, a minimum of two weeks from the start date of the program or class is required to receive a full refund. Refunds are not issued after the program or class start date. There is a \$5.00 processing fee on all refunds.

Please be sure to use your most up-to-date e-mail address upon registering. Your e-mail will be used to receive receipts, notifications, and more. As a policy, we do not share e-mail addresses.



Summer Payment Plan

Whitemarsh Township provides the option of deferring your camp payments into monthly payments at the time of registration. Your total balance is divided by the amount of months between the registration date and August. Your first month's balance is used as your deposit. Your payments will come out each month on the same date as the date that you registered using the same debit or credit card that you provide to the Township at the time of registration.

Please note that there is an administrative fee of \$25.00 to utilize a payment plan. This fee is added into your monthly payments.

Those individuals entering into the payment plan agreement will be solely responsible for all payments and the completion of the payment plan, otherwise the participant will be withdrawn from the program.

Whitemarsh Township recognizes that there are some cases in which parental custody may be shared, or one person has been granted sole custody. The parent registering the child for a program or entering into a payment plan is solely responsible for payment of that program. 


